Gentlemen:

This letter is to provide information concerning access of NRC contractors to your facility for the purpose of conducting a design inspection. The onsite phase of the visit at St. Lucie is scheduled for November 18, 1996, through January 10, 1997.

The Enclosure lists the NRC contractors who will be visiting your facility. For those individuals, who have a clearance and have completed appropriate training, we request unescorted access to your vital and protected areas. For all others listed, we request escorted access. This does not preclude the granting of a higher level of access, consistent with your approved Security Plan, if you so choose.

This letter does not supersede our previous correspondence dated October 1, 1996, regarding NRC personnel access; however, as indicated on the Enclosure, it provides identification of additional personnel who should only be permitted access for the dates specified in the above paragraph.

Should you have any questions concerning this matter, we will be happy to discuss them with you.
