SUBJECT: SAFETY PARAMETER DISPLAY SYSTEM (SUPPLEMENT 1 TO NUREG-0737,  
GENERIC LETTER 82-33) (TAC 51265)

Re: Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station

You are required by Supplement 1 to NUREG-0737, Generic Letter 82-33 dated December 17, 1982, to develop a Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) for Oyster Creek. The staff has reviewed your submittals dated April 2, June 6 and September 28, 1984.

Based on the enclosed evaluation of the licensee's SPDS documentation, the staff concludes that it is acceptable for you to continue implementing the SPDS program for Oyster Creek. However, the staff recommends that the source range monitors be added as an input to the Oyster Creek SPDS and that you evaluate other means to assure the data displayed are valid to supplement limit checking if a redundant input is not available. By the Confirmatory Order dated June 12, 1984, you are required to have the SPDS fully operational and the control room operators trained by the end of the Cycle 11 Refueling outage.

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
