Ref. Exxon's letter to NRC dated December 27, 1985

Dear Mr. Thorne:

This is to amend our letter dated September 11, 1985 as follows:

Increase from 475,801 kgs of uranium (17,092 kgs U-235)
to 549,801 kgs of uranium (19,732 kgs U-235).

The increased quantity will be used as follows:

22,420 kgs U (880 kgs U-235) for KRB II C
additional requirement for XN-1
25,800 kgs U (960 kgs U-235) for Blayais 1, 2 and 3
reload XN-8
25,780 kgs U (800 kgs U-235) for Biblis A
reload XN8B and rods for XN-11

74,000 kgs U (2640 kgs U-235) total increase

All other data of our letters of February 4, 1985, March 18, 1985
and September 11, 1985 remain unchanged.
