COMMENTS:

I disapprove of going forward with Option 3, as recommended by the staff. Instead, I approve of Option 1 in the paper, that the rule should be withdrawn. The staff has failed to make a compelling case that for health and safety reasons such a burden is justified. The reporting requirements of this proposed rule are by definition, only applicable to events that do not cause significant risk to public health and safety. Staff has the opportunity to review and evaluate licensee reaction to such events at the time of inspection, and take any action deemed appropriate. I do not believe that NRC knowledge of such events will result in any reduction of risk.
