
Dear Mr. Bernero:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that we propose to release the two shift advisors currently being utilized at Limerick Generating Station on January 15, 1986. This letter is submitted pursuant to the requirements contained in Attachment 2 to Operating License NPF-39 which requires that, "The NRC shall be notified at least 30 days prior to the release of any specially assigned advisors".

By January 15, 1986, the two Shift Superintendents who now require advisors will meet the experience criteria specified in the Operating License, and the plant will have operated up to 100% power for significant periods. It is for these reasons that we are confident the advisors may be released at that time.
