SUBJECT: DANIEL INTERNATIONAL, WOLF CREEK
ALLEGED IMPROPER INTERPRETATION OF NRC REGULATIONS
BY DANIEL INTERNATIONAL QC SUPERVISORS

REPORT NUMBER: Q4-83-014

1. On June 9, 1983, Office of Investigations Field Office, Region IV, received a handwritten letter dated June 3, 1983, from [redacted]
2. [redacted] states in his letter a number of concerns he has regarding the technical interpretation of NRC Regulations by Daniel International QC supervisors. [redacted] states he feels that Daniel International QC supervisors are improperly conducting inspection due to a lack of understanding of NRC Regulations.
3. [redacted] remarked in his letter that he and two other QC Inspectors, Rick BULLOCK and David FLOWERS, "had our lives physically threatened with bodily harm by some craft personnel."
4. On June 14, 1983, at 2145, [redacted] was telephonically contacted and asked to elaborate on the threat he received. [redacted] stated that approximately 4 or 5 weeks ago, some craft personnel wrote comments on the "porto john" walls that stated, "kill QC," and also statements such as [redacted] explained there were also some obscene comments that he would not repeat.
5. [redacted] stated that Daniel International conducted an investigation, and a craft fitter named [redacted] confessed to writing the threatening comments about QC inspectors. [redacted] remarked that Daniel International fired him for "defacing company property," not for threatening QC inspectors. [redacted] stated that after [redacted] termination, the QC inspectors have not been threatened again.
6. This information is provided to Region IV for review and evaluation. At this time, no further investigation on these allegations is anticipated by the Region IV OI Field Office.
