Dear Mr Saltarelli:

The following appropriate action shall be undertaken by Brown & Root in response to the findings of the subject review. (These findings will have been presented both verbally and in report form by Quadrex to Brown & Root on May 7, 1981).

1. Those findings identified as most serious

- a. Brown & Root should review these items and report to HL&P in writing, no later than noontime on May 8, 1981, whether or not these problems constitute a potential reportable problem in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). Appropriate rationale shall be provided which justifies your conclusions. HL&P in turn will have to make its judgment and report any potential 50.55(e) problems to the NRC prior to close of business on May 8, 1981.

2. With regard to all the findings reported from the Quadrex review, Brown & Root should undertake the following action:

- a. Brown & Root should identify a plan of action to review each finding and establish a strategy for dealing with the concerns identified.
- b. Brown & Root should establish a schedule for conducting the reviews identified in "a" above.

- c. Brown & Root should identify what designs, if any, owing to problems uncovered in the review, require reverification, or reanalysis and/or redesign. Appropriate stop work orders should be issued to Construction identifying any activities that should be deferred pending completion of the reverification, or reanalysis and/or redesign.
- d. Brown & Root should feature the impact of these reverifications, or reanalyses and/or redesigns in their reforecasting activity, identifying the cost and schedule impact from both an engineering as well as a construction viewpoint.

In view of the importance to take timely and positive action relative to the Quadrex findings, it is requested that Brown & Root Project Management provide a weekly report as part of its meeting with HL&P Project Management, highlighting Brown & Root's progress in dealing with the above.
