DEAR MR. GUINN:

WE WOULD LIKE TO AMEND THE ABOVE-NAMED LICENSE NUMBER UNDER CON-  
DITION 12 TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

LICENSED MATERIAL SHALL BE USED BY, OR UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND  
IN THE PHYSICAL PRESENCE OF DALE CLARK, KEN JORGENSEN, MIKE MURRAY  
OR JOHN ALMON.

MR. JOHN ALMON HAS HAD EXTENSIVE FIELD TRAINING UNDER MY SUPERVISION.  
HE HAS USED THE CAMPBELL PACIFIC ON A NUMBER OF STREET AND WATER LINE  
PROJECTS WHILE WITH THE CITY OF GREAT FALLS. MR. ALMON HAS BEEN EM-  
PLOYED WITH THE CITY FOR APPROXIMATELY SEVEN MONTHS. HE HAS WORKED  
WITH THOMAS, DEAN & HOSKINS, A LOCAL ENGINEERING FIRM, FOR APPROXI-  
MATELY FOUR YEARS. HE HAD TWO YEARS OF TRAINING WITH THE TROXLER  
NUCLEAR DEVICE WHILE UNDER THEIR SUPERVISION. HE ALSO ATTENDED A  
ONE-DAY SCHOOL FOR THE TROXLER IN HELENA, MONTANA.

IF THE NUCLEAR IS RUN OVER OR DAMAGED, HE HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED TO DO  
THE FOLLOWING: (1) ROPE OFF THE AREA, INCLUDING THE EQUIPMENT DOING  
THE DAMAGE, AND KEEP EVERYONE AWAY; (2) CALL THE POLICE AND FIRE  
DEPARTMENTS; (3) CALL THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CHECK FOR  
RADIATION LOSS; (4) CALL THE MANUFACTURER FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS,  
AND (5) CALL THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION.

IF THE GAUGE IS STOLEN, WE ARE TO NOTIFY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, LOCAL  
PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE FACTORY.
