In a December 3, 1985 memorandum to you, Mr. John H. Frye, III, Administrative Judge, transmitted a copy of a request for a hearing by the Native Americans for a Clean Environment Client Council on Sequoyah Fuels Corporation's Comprehensive Radiological Waste Storage and Disposal Plan. This plan was submitted to NRC staff on May 24, 1985, pursuant to condition 2 of license amendment 25 to License SUB-1010 held by Sequoyah Fuels Corporation ("SFC").


We wish to inform you that the NRC staff, in their facility relicensing action of September 20, 1985, added license condition 21, which requires SFC to prepare and submit changes to its decommissioning plan by October 1, 1986. This plan is to encompass the permanent disposal of all solid wastes generated at the facility. Because SFC is required to submit further information relating to solid-waste disposal and because SFC has no immediate need to pursue any on-site disposal of wastes, we
