Mississippi Power and Light

Areas Discussed:

1. Qualification Cards

- Revised guidance on qual card implementation issued
- Qual card reviewed by shift supervisor (SROS)
- Developing NRC style Matrix for signoffs of important attributes
- Matrix includes theory, practical factors, system knowledge, technical specification
- Signoffs to be accomplished by shift supervisors (SROS)
- Two classes: One on training; one on shift

2. Relief on Suspended Licenses

- Issue licenses withheld after completion of qual cards (4 licenses)?
- Reinstate three licenses after completion of qual cards/correction of weaknesses?

3. Standards for Acceptable Performance

4. Certification of Board

- After qualification cards are complete, operator Training Evaluation Board will certify training complete and satisfactory performance on oral exam
- MP&L will submit letter stating board certification complete

5. Feedback of Generic Problems & Training Program

- Feedback from operator
- Feedback from review of exams/records
- Tracking of weaknesses to identify generic problems

6. STA Certification

- 3 STA's on-shift; 3 additional have completed training

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- Review of training to identify weaknesses
- Retraining if necessary

7. Shift Advisors

- Present advisors have three weeks of system training and have been examined
- MP&L will review exams and retrain in weak areas
- MP&L will review qualifications, purpose and use of shift advisors and make determination of adequate training

8. Implementation of Practical Factors

- Will be accomplished as appropriate in plant or on simulator
- MP&L will review qual cards and identify appropriate locations and how, i.e., walk-thru/accomplish, the item will be complete

9. Documentation

- Short term - all documents retained
- Long term - retain main documents
- Discussed types of documents to be used to adequately show that training is completed

10. Removal of Operators

- Upon identification of significant weaknesses operator will be relieved of licensed duties
- MP&L program will address how removal will be accomplished

11. Certification of Instructors (Quadrex)

- Schedule for certification
- Use of instructors prior to certification
