12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, James Lowright, James Diment or individuals designated by the Environmental Control Department of New England Nuclear Corporation.

Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated September 15, 1977; letters dated January 9, 1978, March 28, 1978, April 17, 1980, May 22, 1980, October 16, 1980, March 22, 1982, and June 14, 1982; and application dated October 22, 1982, and letter dated February 20, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
