Re: Materials License No. 29-20512-01, As Amended

Dear Dr. Glenn:

This letter is a request to amend the above referenced materials license in the following respects:

1. Subitem 9.A, Authorized Use: To include language that the T-54 explosives detector is also known as the Scanex Jr. There have been no alterations nor modifications to the T-54; instead this is simply an additional name used for marketing purposes.

2. Subitem 9.A, Authorized Use: To include the manufacture, service and distribution of the Scentor Jr. The Scentor Jr. is a smaller version of the Scentor for which we now possess a license. The Scentor's exterior package has been reduced in size to form the Scentor Jr. The interior components and mechanism, however, are identical to the Scentor. The same radiation caution labeling will be affixed and the instruction manual will contain the required language.

The license we now possess should remain identical in all other respects.

Pursuant to my conversation with Ms. Glenda Jackson of the License Fee Management Branch I enclose a check in the amount of \$120.00 made payable to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for an amendment of our license.
