It was pointed out to us during a recent AEC inspection that we are prohibited by Paragraph 15 on our by-product material license number 24-1113-13 (A65) to install, relocate, maintain or repair our four (4) Ohmart radiation gauges. This is an extreme inconvenience to us since we operate our gauges on a 7 day, 24 hour basis and since outside AEC licensed service people are not readily available to us.

These units are sealed source, pipeline units (maximum radiation level 3.2 mr/hr on the surface) such that relocation or installation is nothing more than pipe fitting work. We are well aware of the potential hazards of the units and in fact have personnel in our plant who have experience in handling such devices from installations at our Columbia, Tenn. plant. We make no request to be allowed to remove the source from its shielding or in any way destroy or dispose of the device.
