Enclosed are two copies of a request for amendment number 3 for Material License Number 46-15078-02. This license is for a nuclear density and moisture content gauge possessed by the Branch of Roads, Olympic Peninsula Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs in Hoquiam, Washington. We wish to amend the following item on our current license:

Condition 12 - This condition needs to be revised to indicate that the radiation protection officer for the Branch of Roads will be Joseph Bonga. The nuclear gauge will be used by Highway Engineer Joseph Bonga or Civil Engineering Technician Tony Shay both of whom have had training and experience in the use of the nuclear gauge. The previous responsible individual, Bryon Frost no longer works at the Olympic Peninsula Agency.
