Dear Mr. Delno:

This letter is in response to your application received July 18, 1985, for a byproduct material license. Please provide the following information so that we can continue our review:

1. Your application requested use of a 3M Model 4F6S sealed source in the Wilson Model 2202 wall caliper. Our catalogs indicate that the 3M Model 4F6H is the correct source designation for use with this caliper. After discussion with the manufacturer, indicate the source/device combination for which you wish to be licensed.
2. Identify the supplier of film or TLD dosimeters to be used. Also confirm that such dosimeters will be worn by all users of the device.
3. During my conversation with you by telephone on August 13, 1985, you indicated that License No. 35-21336-01 issued to Continental Inspection Services Company is not currently in use, since that firm is no longer in business. You stated that this license may be used again before its expiration, however. Confirm these facts in a separate letter to us.

To assist you in providing this information, we have enclosed a copy of the guide, "Guide for the Applications for Licenses for the Use of Sealed Sources in Portable Gauging Devices (1985)."

We will continue our review of your application upon receipt of this information, in duplicate.
