Thank you for your letter dated October 19, 1982, (reference P-82463) which discusses emergency access by NRC personnel. We reviewed Enclosure 5 with your suggestions and questions in mind and we have made substantial changes to the language of that enclosure. Please review the enclosed revision.

It should be noted that this enclosure relates only to those NRC inspectors who are officially participating in the drill. We are not addressing the matter of firemen or other outside emergency personnel who you may wish to admit in another way.

Please note that the prospective inspectors to be involved, listed by name, have been issued special NRC badge: with a numbering system that is independent from that of the routine access NRC badge.

NRC EMERGENCY SITE TEAM

This certifies that the persons listed below are employees of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission. To the extent of our knowledge, these persons do not possess adverse character traits or indications of aberrant behavior. These employees have been screened to the national level (including a criminal records check); no disqualifying offenses were noted. Trustworthiness has been determined by a review of the individual's employment records. Based on the above, these employees qualify for unescorted access to the protected and vital areas of your facilities.

Certain referenced NRC requirements, set out below, are to be waived by the licensee under the following conditions:

1. An actual emergency which is declared by the site or utility management;
2. An emergency drill which is programmed and declared by the site or utility management in which NRC is officially participating;
3. NRC employees listed below must produce and then display, or openly wear, the special NRC RIV Emergency Site Team badge along with any badge that you may elect to issue:

4. At the announced cessation of the emergency drill, as declared by the site or utility, NRC employees who are involved in the waiving process will report to a designated location for normal processing on departure.

The following certain NRC requirements are to be waived by the licensee in regard to the persons listed below only during a declared actual emergency or specified emergency drill period:

1. Search function for detection of firearms, explosives and incendiary devices (10 CFR 73.55(d)(1));
2. Search of all hand-carried items (10 CFR 73.55(d)(2));
3. Use of a numbered picture badge identification system (10 CFR 73.55(d)(5));
4. Registration function, inclusive of name, date, time, purpose of visit, employment affiliation, citizenship, and individual to be visited (10 CFR 73.55(d)(6)).
