SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF GRANT NRC-04-93-089

Please terminate grant NRC-04-93-089 with the University of Arizona. The performance of the University does not meet reasonable standards. The substandard performance has included the following:

- The principal investigator was over six months late in developing and providing a milestone plan which could be used to monitor progress.
- The principal investigator was over three months late in preparing and making the annual report.
- The contractually required annual report was one quarter page when it was finally submitted to DCPM. The report is inadequate as a summation of a year's work. It does not describe the work that has been accomplished, discuss problems encountered, and discuss plans for the second year's work.

Thus based on continuing unresponsiveness of the principal investigator, I recommend that DCPM terminate the grant.
