

Dear Sir:

I would like to request an increase in the radioactivity limit, item 8 A of the reference license, from 16 millicuries to 30 millicuries. We are now receiving shipments of P^{32} (irradiated human teeth) at the rate of about 16 millicuries per month. While the time interval between shipments is two half lives, previous shipments still in storage in the laboratory put us slightly over our license limit of 16 millicuries.
