
On August 14, 1953 National Lead Company was issued Form AEC-374 Authorization of Radioisotope Procurement Serial No. 21459 for 200 millicuries of Cobalt 60 in sealed metal sources.

This cobalt 60 has been used since that date in liquid level gauges in the Metals Refinery at Fredericktown, Missouri. This plant has been rented by National Lead Company from the General Services Administration, and on May 1, 1961 we are relinquishing our lease. Since this material along with the plant is G.S.A. property we wish to know what steps need to be taken to relieve National Lead Company as the licensee for use of this material.

I am completely in the dark as to how to proceed on this, and your name was suggested by Mr. Karl T. Ball, Sales Manager, Instruments, Inc., who sold us this material.
