Gentlemen:

This is in response to your letter dated May 12, 1962.

If your corporation proposes to purchase the National Lead Company facility at Fredericktown, Missouri and to own, possess or use the sources of cobalt 60 currently licensed to National Lead Company for use there under Hypocobalt Material License No. 24-3070-1, it will be necessary for Universal Minerals & Metals Inc. to apply for a new license. Application for this license may be made on the enclosed Form AEE-513. This Form should be filled out as completely as possible in order to permit careful evaluation of the radiation safety aspects of your proposed program. As you will note, possession and use of hypocobalt material is subject to the enclosed AEE regulations "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," 10 CFR 20 and "Handling of Hypocobalt Material," 10 CFR 21.

Following the issuance of the proposed new license to Universal Minerals & Metals Inc. and the transfer to disposal of all licensed material, National Lead Company should request termination of License No. 24-3070-1.
