

this location.

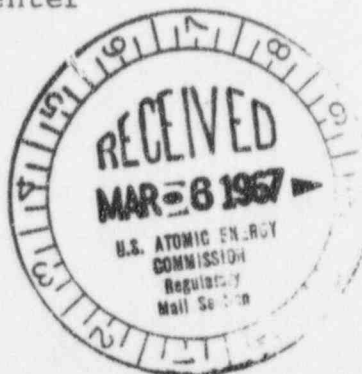
The delay in our renewal application, in part, is due
