
Dear Mr. Brinkman:

Attached is our application on form AEC-313 by which we request amendment of our existing license 24-1113-8(G65). In this amendment we request changes in the individual users to delete Dr. Sharp and to add W. S. Coakley. Under the isotopes an addition to the three Strontium-90 sources now covered by the existing license we request the addition of a Tritium source and the addition of several other small sources as noted. As our application states, these additional isotopes, other than the Tritium, will be used in Mossbauer experiments only. The Tritium will be used as a source in a gas chromatograph.

We respectfully request your assistance in expediting this license amendment as we are in particular need for the Tritium source.

Will you please let me know if any additional information is required and if there is anything more we can do to be of assistance.
