

SUBJECT: VISIT OF A. S. ALOE SCIENTIFIC REPRESENTATIVE TO ISOTOPE DIVISION  
(MR. PAT GASKINS)

Mr. Pat Gaskins of the above company accompanied by Mr. J. E. McKeowen of Omega Associations, Mt. Vernon, New York, called today to discuss the possible merits of some plastic back absorbent paper which they would like to offer to isotope users. The material is said to be impervious to weak acid solutions and would be useful as table top material in radioisotope laboratories. Dr. Manov discussed the problem to some extent with them.

Mr. Gaskins had a pre-release Aloe catalog with him in which Aloe is offering a shielding syringe for medical administration of radioisotopes. The device had a built-in flash light to facilitate its use and carried a price quotation of slightly less than \$100.

Both Mr. Gaskins and Mr. McKeowen have attended the ORINS lecture series.
