NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on September 9, 1985, and in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 12 states that licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, Mervin J. Specht, M.D., or Dale R. Shampo, M.D.


Contrary to this requirement, since July 1985, licensed material was used by an individual not authorized by the license.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
