OFFICE VISIT OF MR. HENRY L. ETTMAN AND MR. PAT GASKINS, ALOE SCIENTIFIC
DIVISION OF A. S. ALOE COMPANY, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI, NOVEMBER 12, 1957.

The visit was made concerning the type of laboratory equipment required of applicants for byproduct material license. Mr. Ettman is vice-president of this company and Mr. Gaskins is sales representative for this area. Copies of Ward's paper, "Design of Laboratories for Safe Use of Radioisotopes;" Morgan's paper, "Facilities and Equipment for Isotopes Program;" Bizzell's paper, "Equipment for Radioisotope Laboratories;" Regulations, Part 20 and 30; and RC-12 were given to them. They stated that they were interested in the latter publications since many times questions concerning AEC regulations and requirements for radioisotope users were asked by their customers. The three papers on facilities and laboratory equipment appeared to supply the particular information which they desired. During the conversation it was mentioned that frequently manufacturers of radioisotope laboratory equipment supplied brochures to the Extension which can be used to identify particular equipment of applicants for license. Mr. Ettman stated that they would send several brochures to the Extension which describes equipment which they distribute.
