SUPPLEMENTAL ANSWER TO INTERROGATORY NO. 21

The measures described in Kerr-McGee's original answer to this interrogatory and in its supplemental answer are all the measures of which Kerr-McGee is currently aware. The cost of those measures has not yet been determined, but is expected to be relatively small compared to that of the remainder of the project and should diminish significantly over time as the vegetative cover becomes fully established.


SUPPLEMENTAL ANSWER TO INTERROGATORY NO. 75




