Gentlemen:

This is to acknowledge receipt of transmitted changes to the Big Rock Point Plant Site Emergency Plan, Volume 9, Revision 79, and your letter of November 18, 1985 which included a revision to Chapter 9, Section 7.1.4.B.

This revision as listed in the attachment to your November letter stated, in effect, that the Emergency Officer will have command and control upon arrival at the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) about one and one half hours after the Site Area Emergency is declared. Also, the Emergency Officer along with the EOF Director will, upon arrival at the EOF, be involved in the protective action recommendations, since they will have been notified of the emergency prior to the Alert classification. We have reviewed this change to Chapter 9, Section 7.1.4.B, of the Big Rock Point Plant Site Emergency Plan and find it acceptable. Also, we have reviewed the other changes to the Plan in Revision 79 and determined that they are consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54(q) and do not decrease the effectiveness of your plan. These changes are, therefore, acceptable.

Please be reminded that 10 CFR 50.54(q) requires NRC approval of any changes to your plan which may decrease the effectiveness of the plan. However, if your safety review indicates no decrease in emergency preparedness effectiveness, then changes can be made without prior NRC approval. In all cases, you must furnish copies of each proposed change to the NRC in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q). Also, any changes to the Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures should be made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix E, Section V (Implementing Procedures).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.






