POSSIBLE VIOLATION 10 CFR 19.13 - FITZSIMONS GENERAL HOSPITAL  
ACTION ITEM HO1458F4

The failure to respond to requests for exposure histories by two persons formerly in the U. S. Army at Fitzsimons Hospital, Denver, Colorado, License No. 05-00046-13, was investigated on December 10, 1976. The two individuals are listed on the enclosures to this memorandum which were received from G. Wayne Kerr, Assistant Director for State Agreements Program, Office of State Programs.

A detailed search of Fitzsimons' records by Col. P. E. Sieber and staff disclosed that no records for the two individuals were currently at Fitzsimons. In addition, no record of receipt of requests to Fitzsimons from the University of Alabama for exposure histories was found during the search.

Col. P. E. Sieber stated that personnel records are forwarded to new duty stations when a change of station is made, and that personnel exposure records are sent to the following address upon separation from the Army:

Therefore, requests for exposure histories should be sent to the above address.
