5. The following activities under your license (identified in Item No. 3 above) appear to be in noncompliance with AEC regulations or license requirements, as indicated.	
<p>a. During the period May 1, 1964, to April 26, 1965, 5 millicurie quantities of I-131 in the form of cholografin were procured on sixteen separate occasions, contrary to the provisions of License Item 8.F. which limit the possession of I-131 as cholografin to 2 millicuries.</p> <p>b. During the period June 1, 1964, to April 26, 1965, 2 millicurie quantities of I-125 in the form of iodinated human serum albumin were procured on seven separate occasions, contrary to the provisions of License Item 8.J. which limit the possession of I-125 as iodinated human serum albumin to 1 millicurie.</p> <p>c. During the period January 1, 1965, to April 26, 1965, 5 millicurie quantities of Cr-51 in the form of sodium chromate were procured on eleven separate occasions, contrary to the provisions of License Item 8.S. which limit the possession of Cr-51 as sodium chromate to 4 millicuries.</p> <p>d. On September 22, 1964, 128 microcuries of K₂S₂O₈ and 110 microcuries of C-14 were administered to rats at the summit of Pikes Peak, Colorado, contrary to the provisions of License Condition No. 10, which specify that the authorized places for such use are Fitzsimons General Hospital and U. S. Army Medical Research and Nutrition Laboratory, Denver, Colorado.</p>
