Subject: GENERAL ELECTRIC NUCLEAR BUSINESS OPERATIONS ORGANIZATIONAL CHANGES

Gentlemen:

In Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A, Revision 5, the Nuclear Energy Business Operations of the General Electric Company committed to notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission of organizational changes affecting the NEBO Quality Assurance Program within thirty days of implementation. In compliance with that commitment, notification of organization changes in the Nuclear Energy Business Operations is transmitted herein.

These organizational changes are business oriented and will not result in any decrease in the effectiveness of the overall quality assurance program as documented in Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A, Revision 5. All applicable quality assurance functions have been retained and the independence of persons and organizations performing quality assurance functions has been preserved.

Specifically, effective December 12, 1985 (except as noted on the Organizational diagram), the Nuclear Energy Business Operations were restructured as follows:

1. The position General Manager-Nuclear Systems & Services is discontinued.

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
2. The position General Manager-Nuclear products & Engineering Services is established reporting to the Vice President & General Manager-NEBO. This position consolidates most of the services business other than field services. It includes those activities now in the Nuclear Services Products Department's scope plus Plant Technology, Reliability Engineering, Safety & Licensing, and Training.
3. The position General Manager-Nuclear Projects & Customer Services will report to the Vice President and General Manager-NEBO. It will serve both the Nuclear Products & Engineering Services and Nuclear Field Services components.
4. The position Manager-Nuclear Energy Business Development is established reporting to the Vice President & General Manager-NEBO.
5. The position Manager-Nuclear Energy Business Planning & Materials is discontinued and its functions transferred as follows:
 - o Business Planning to Nuclear Energy Business Development.
 - o Nuclear Systems Marketing to Nuclear Projects & Customer Services.
 - o Indirect Material & Traffic, Engineered Equipment Purchasing, Purchasing & Logistics Support, and Facilities Operation to Nuclear Products & Engineering Services.
 - o Wilmington Purchasing to Wilmington Manufacturing.
6. The position Program Manager-PWR Services is transferred to Nuclear Projects & Customer Services.
7. The functions of Plant Technology and Safety & Licensing are transferred from Nuclear Systems Technology to Nuclear Products & Engineering Services.
8. The function of Reliability Engineering is transferred from the Office of Chief Engineer to Nuclear Products & Engineering Services.
9. The Nuclear Fuel Manufacturing Department and the Nuclear Fuel Engineering Department are discontinued and their functions consolidated into the new component Nuclear Fuel Engineering & Manufacturing.
10. The Training function of Nuclear Training & Field Services is transferred to the Nuclear Products & Engineering Services and established as the Nuclear Training Services component.
11. Irradiation Processing (IPO) is transferred from Nuclear Fuel Engineering to Waste Management Services.

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12. The Quality Assurance & Reliability Operation (QA&RO) is renamed Quality Assurance Operation (QAO).
13. Figure 1, attached, provides an overview of the current NEEO organization. Several management and engineering functions are being consolidated to support our ongoing business.

These organizational changes and any associated quality system documentation changes will be addressed in the next revision of Licensing Topical Report NEDO-11209-04A.
