Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant - Units 1 and 2
NRC Generic Letter 85-09, Reactor Trip Breaker
Technical Specification Change

Gentlemen:

By letter dated October 31, 1985, Alabama Power Company committed to provide changes to the Farley Nuclear Plant Technical Specifications by December 16, 1985 in response to Generic Letter 85-09. Accordingly, Attachment 1 lists the changed pages and provides the proposed changes in response to Generic Letter 85-09.

It should be recognized that the Farley Nuclear Plant - Unit 2 was one of the first plants to install the automatic shunt trip breaker modification. The automatic shunt trip breaker modification has also been installed on Unit 1. Alabama Power Company has previously implemented testing of the modified reactor trip breakers, the bypass breakers and the main control board switches at the Farley Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. A description of the testing currently performed at the Farley Nuclear Plant is provided in Alabama Power Company letters dated October 20 and November 7, 1983 and NRC Safety Evaluation Report dated September 20, 1983. In addition, FSAI Section 7.2.2.2.1.G was updated to reflect these major testing commitments.

It should be noted that page 3/4 3-14 for Units 1 and 2 reflect the additional technical specification change submitted to the NRC by letter dated November 22, 1985.
