NOTICE OF VIOLATION

During an NRC inspection conducted on November 1, 1985, violations of NRC requirements were identified. In accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1985), the violations are listed below:

1. 10 CFR 34.33(c) requires that pocket dosimeters shall be checked at periods not to exceed one year for correct response to radiation.

Contrary to this requirement, records indicated that no calibrations had been performed on dosimeters 12509, 7080119, 3051402, and 5403B between November 1, 1984 and November 1, 1985. These dosimeters were used by licensee personnel during this period.

This a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

2. 10 CFR 34.24 requires, in part, that each radiation survey instrument be calibrated at intervals not to exceed three months and a record shall be maintained of the results of each instrument calibration and date thereof for two years after the date of calibration.

Contrary to this requirement, records were not available for the instrument designated as #1 for calibration during the period of August 1, 1985 and November 1, 1985 although it was in current use.

This a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

3. 10 CFR 20.408(b) requires, in part, that when an individual terminates employment with a licensee, the licensee shall furnish to the Commission a report of the individual's exposure to radiation. 10 CFR 20.409(b) requires that when a report pursuant to 10 CFR 20.408 is required, the licensee shall also notify the individual. Such notice shall be transmitted at a time not later than the transmittal to the Commission and shall comply with the provisions of 10 CFR 19.13(a).

Contrary to these requirements, termination reports were not submitted for two individuals who terminated their employment during the third quarter of 1985 nor were they sent to the individuals.

This a Severity Level V violation (Supplement IV).

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4. 10 CFR 34.27(c) requires, in part, that the plant or site where licensed material is used, be included on the utilization log.

Contrary to this requirement, the utilization records of one individual gave no indication of the location of use during the period January 1985 through August 1985.

This a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

5. 10 CFR 71.5(a) requires, in part, that no licensee shall transport any licensed material outside the confines of his plant or other place of use, or deliver any licensed material to a carrier for transport, unless the licensee complies with applicable requirements of the regulations appropriate to the mode of transport, of the Department of Transportation in 49 CFR Parts 170-189.

49 CFR 173.25(b) requires, in part, that authorized packages being shipped in outside containers must have the containers marked with the proper shipping name and labeled as required by subchapter C of Title 49. The outside containers must also be marked "INSIDE PACKAGES COMPLY WITH PRESCRIBED SPECIFICATIONS" when specification packages are used.

Contrary to this requirement, outside containers enclosing DOT specification Type B packages of radioactive material were not labeled in accordance with 49 CFR 173.25 in two of the licensee's vehicles on November 1, 1985.

This a Severity Level V violation (Supplement V).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, Tulsa Gamma Ray, Incorporated is hereby required to submit to this office, within 30 days of the date of the letter transmitting this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each violation: (1) the reason for the violation if admitted, (2) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved, (3) The corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; (4) The date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending the response time.
