Dear Mr. Walker:

In reply to your letter of 28 February 1968, the following corrective action has been taken in connection with our AEC License No. 05-00046-13:

a. We are requesting that our license for strontium 85 for use in bone scans be altered so that we can maintain 3.0 mc in our possession at any one time. This is well within the limits of safety and will allow for the occasional overlapping of shipments.

b. We are requesting that our cesium 137 be placed on our license for use as a calibration standard.
