The Commission met with the members of the Advisory Committee for Review of the Enforcement Policy and was briefed on their report entitled, "Report of the Advisory Committee for Review of the Enforcement Policy," dated November 22, 1985. As a result of the meeting, the EDO is requested to take the following actions:

- (a) Review the findings of the Advisory Committee and submit comments to the Commission. The staff should coordinate with other offices (e.g., OI, OPA, or others) those portions of the report which are applicable to them.
