
Gentlemen:

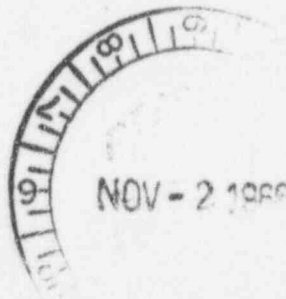
