Gentlemen:

This letter relates to the discussion Mr. Paas of this office held with Lt. Col. John Campbell and Major Gerald A. King at the conclusion of his recent inspection. In particular, certain of the activities conducted in connection with your license appeared to be in noncompliance with AEC requirements. These items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in paragraph 5 of the attached Form AEC-592. It was noted that items 5.a. and 5.b. were corrected at the time of inspection, and no additional correspondence regarding these items is required.

The purpose of this letter is to give you an opportunity to advise us, in writing, of your position concerning these items, and of any corrective steps you have taken, or plan to take, with respect to them, including specific actions that will preclude their recurrence. The date all corrective action was, or will be, completed should be included. Your reply should be sent to us within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter to assure that it will receive prompt attention in our further evaluation of this matter.
