This is to inform you that the gas chromatograph containing a Hydrogen-3 Foil Source (Analytical Instrument Development Detector Cell Model No. 510-6607) is being transferred to Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation, Engineering Laboratory, located at 1600 Dublin Road, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The Transmission Corporation is in the process of applying for a license for the hydrogen-3 source. Therefore, since the Service Corporation Research Department will no longer have any sources, once the transfer of the hydrogen-3 source is completed, we plan to allow License 34-18762-01 to expire. A possible problem is that the Transmission Corporation may not have their license when our expires. Could you inform us of the proper procedure to follow if this situation arises.

Also enclosed is a copy of a letter dated April 17, 1985, stating that the 2 curie Cesium-137 sealed source was returned to the manufacturer. This letter should already be in your files, although our telephone conversation indicated otherwise.

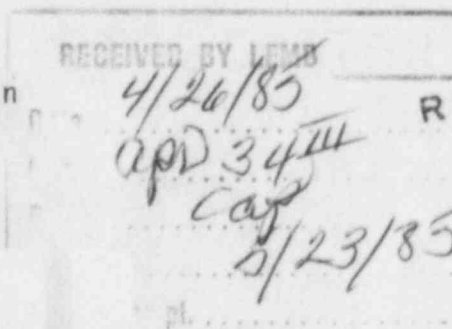
