In accordance with letter dated July 29, 1985, License Number 48-00810-02 is amended as follows:

Condition 18. is amended to read:

18. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated February 22, 1982; letters dated January 7, 1982, November 2, 1982, April 12, 1984 (with enclosures), July 9, 1984 and July 29, 1985 (with attachments); and Model ALARA Program as contained in Appendix O of Regulatory Guide 10.8, October 1980. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

Condition 19. is added:

19. Notwithstanding the requirements of Section 35.14(b)(1) and(2) the licensee may transfer and receive Groups I, II and III radiopharmaceuticals (except Mo99/Tc99m generators) to and from La Crosse Lutheran Hospital/Gundersen Clinic, La Crosse, Wisconsin, License Number 48-01277-02.
