In your memorandum and order of November 5, 1985, you do not list time on the agenda of the hearing concerning Sequoyah Fuels for all parties who have been granted status to appear.

The National Water Center (NWC) of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has been admitted as a party, yet is not given a time on the agenda. Peoples' Action for a Safe Environment (PASE) of Fayetteville, Arkansas, had been told they could make a limited appearance statement, yet they are not mentioned at all. I wish to be assured that these concerned citizens from my state will be permitted to speak at the hearing.

The Arkansas Peace Center of Little Rock is representing my interests in this matter. I ask to be placed on the service list so that I will receive documents at the same time as the APC. It would be helpful for us to be reading them at the same time, rather than my reading them later, or having them read to me on the phone.

Also, I wish to protest the informal nature of this hearing and the severe restrictions placed upon parties as to what subjects may be discussed at the hearing.
