Gentlemen:

This refers to License 34-01055-01, Amendment No. 61, which was issued on May 1, 1985. The amendment was issued in response to your letter dated April 2, 1985, to add uranyl acetate.

Through an oversight, the amendment was issued without remittance of the prescribed application fee. We received your check for \$120; however, your request should have been accompanied by an application fee of \$350 as specified in fee Category 2G and Footnote 1(d) of \$170.31 of the enclosed 10 CFR 170. Footnote 1(d) states in part that an application for amendment to a materials license that would place the license in a higher fee category or add a new category shall be accompanied by the prescribed application fee for the new category. The addition of source material increased the scope of your licensed program to include fee Category 2G. You are requested to remit the additional \$230 fee within twenty (20) days from the date of this letter. Payment should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and sent to the attention of Cheryl Phillips at our Washington, D.C. address.

We apologize for the delay in notifying you of the additional fee due. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please let us know.
