This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Mr. I. T. Yin of this office and Mr. J. R. Fair of NRC-IE on November 12 through December 6, 1985, of activities at Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1, authorized by NRC Operating License No. LPPF-3 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. S. M. Quennoz and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Notice. A written response is required.
