AGAIN I RESUBMIT COMMENTS ON ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS WHICH I HAD PREVIOUSLY SUBMITTED FOR THE <sup>PREVIOUS</sup> ENFORCEMENT POLICY (49 FR 8583 MAR 85) THE PRESENT (FR 11/20/85) GS AN ENFORCEMENT POLICY REINFORCES THE NRC'S RELUCTANCE TO ADMINISTER ANY EFFECTIVE ENFORCEMENT.

INSTEAD THE NRC RELIES ON A MEDIEVAL "WHIPPING BOY" PRINCIPAL WHICH PUNISHES RATEPAYERS, TAXPAYERS AND STOCKHOLDERS BUT PROTECTS THE ACTUAL PERPETRATOR OF THE VIOLATION.

THE FINE OR COST OF COMPLIANCE RELATED TO A VIOLATION IS "PASSED THRU" TO TAXPAYERS IN THE CASE OF A STATE-CALLED UTILITY, RATEPAYERS DEPENDING ON THE VAGARIES OF STATE UTILITY COMMISSIONS, AND STOCKHOLDERS WHERE FINES ARE ACTUALLY PAID OUT OF PROFITS. I CHALLENGE THE NRC TO SHOW ME ONE CASE WHERE WORKMAN OR MANAGEMENT JUDGED GUILTY OF A VIOLATION ACTUALLY SUFFERED THE CONSEQUENCES.
