PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a(e)(3), enacted into law by section 3 of the Privacy Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-579), the following statement is furnished to individuals who supply information to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on NRC Form 313. This information is maintained in a system of records designated as NRC-3 and described at 40 Federal Register 45334 (October 1, 1975).

1. **AUTHORITY:** Sections 81 and 161(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2111 and 2201(b)).
2. **PRINCIPAL PURPOSE(S):** The information is evaluated by the NRC staff pursuant to the criteria set forth in 10 CFR Parts 30, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 40 to determine whether the application meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Commission's regulations, for the issuance of a radioactive material license or amendment thereof.
3. **ROUTINE USES:** The information may be (a) provided to State health departments for their information and use; and (b) provided to Federal, State, and local health officials and other persons in the event of incident or exposure, for their information, investigation, and protection of the public health and safety. The information may also be disclosed to appropriate Federal, State, and local agencies in the event that the information indicates a violation or potential violation of law and in the course of an administrative or judicial proceeding. In addition, this information may be transferred to an appropriate Federal, State, or local agency to the extent relevant and necessary for an NRC decision or to an appropriate Federal agency to the extent relevant and necessary for that agency's decision about you.


- 1) I have reviewed the January 1985 N.R.C. Guide for the preparation of applications for licenses ... etc.

I have reviewed the attached submission for renewal of our Cobalt-60 license which expires 4/30/85 and find it to comply with the guidelines and quoted code of Federal Requirements.

Provided that the renewal is received by N.R.C. 30 days prior to current license expiration date (4/30/85) and notification of receipt received from N.R.C., current license remains effective until final action on renewal is received by us from N.R.C..

- 2) We will be submitting, by the end of March, an amendment listing 4 additional names for licensing as "Responsible Individuals" to operate the Cobalt facility. We have scheduled "final exams" for these four people over the next week. When completed, written-up and grade assigned, the complete resume for each will be submitted to N.R.C.. We did not want to delay our overall license renewal by waiting to complete this test.

Expect 7 day operation capability by mid-April.

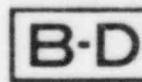
