Dear Sir/Madam:

The Samaritan Hospital has requested me to seek
modification to their Nuclear Medicine license in three
areas:

- 1) Adjustment to the list of official users in which
the names of Drs. Quentin N. Anderson and Joseph M.
Melland are added and the name of Marshall Golden, M.D.
is removed.
- 2) Dr. Quentin N. Anderson is to serve as the R.S.O.
- 3) Permission to aquire and possess sealed sources of
Iodine-125 and Gadolinium-153 for use in bone mineral
assay devices.

In support of user status for Drs. Anderson and
Mellin, I have included a C.V. and pertinent Training and
Experience statements (Forms NRC-313M, parts A&B).


The bone mineral assay device is manufactured by Lunar
Radiation Corp as model SP2 and DP3. The sealed source of
I-125 used in the SP2 has an NRC device registration number
of: NR-430-D-102-S. The Gd-153 sealed source which is used
in the DP3 has an NRC registration number of NR-430-D-101-S.

Since these materials fall under group VI of 10CFR35,
information pertinent to that group is included on form
NRC313. I will be available to provide additional detail
required in support of this request.
