We received your April 1st letter regarding our former employee's actions in Killingly, Connecticut. We appreciate the offer to have a Predecisional Enforcement Conference with your team and would like to request a conference.

For this event in particular, we would welcome the opportunity to share information about our former employee and Terracon's pre-incident efforts to coach and correct her unsafe practices. Additionally, we would like to share with the NRC how this former employee's dishonesty on the day in question hampered our investigation and ultimately delayed both the recovery of the gauge and our reporting. Finally, we can share with you what corrective actions Terracon has taken both with regard to the individual but from a company-wide standpoint as well.

So that our conference can be productive for your team, is there particular information you would like to have beforehand? We are happy to provide whatever response or documentation you would like in advance of the meeting. At the same time, if you prefer to have the conference and then have us follow up with additional information, we are happy to take your lead. Please let us know.
