This refers to your license amendment request dated April 21, 2020. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 26 authorizing the requested additions and increases in materials and possession limits. However, the changes to your Certificate of Financial Assurance was not approved under this licensing action; it will be reviewed under a separate action, Mail Control No 617414.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. You will be periodically inspected by the NRC.
