I regret the late reply to your request for the following information, however, I have been away from the office for the last few weeks.

Our radiation safety officer's responsibilities have been assigned to Mr. John P. Olatta, Supervisory Engineer in our Chemical Manufacturing Division.

Mr. Olatta holds a MS degree in inorganic chemistry from the Michigan State University and has 27 years experience in the chemical manufacturing and processing field.

In the past four years, he has been responsible for the processing and control of thorium material and supervising employee operations.

Mr. Olatta has attended several training programs covering the handling, processing, control, and radiation measurements of our thorium material. He has been and presently is responsible for the sampling and condition of the thorium processing areas.

As part of his assignment as radiation safety officer, he will be responsible for the training of employees who handle or process our thorium material.

Also, per your request, we are instituting a record keeping system which will reflect the total material on hand, withdrawals and disposition of material. This system will be maintained current on a day-to-day entry basis.
