Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated January 30, 1984; letter dated April 23, 1984; application with enclosures and letter dated June 7, 1984; application with letter dated January 3, 1985; letters dated January 19, 1985, February 5, 1985, February 20, 1985, April 20, 1985, and July 3, 1985; and letter received September 9, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
