We are requesting an amendment to NRC License No. 36-19375-01, Expiration Date 8/31/90; Docket No. 030-17523.

James I. Sutton has recently retired from Bonneville Power Administration. He has acted as Radiation Safety Officer since 1975. Jay B. Dick will be the new Radiation Safety Officer for our organization. His experience is listed below:

Mr. Dick completed a 6 month Basic Nuclear Power Engineering course in the U.S. Navy in 1963. He also attended 8 hours of classroom and field instruction on the safe operation, storage, and monitoring of the nuclear density gauge. The instruction was presented through Campbell Pacific Nuclear on February 5, 1986, in Portland, Oregon. The instructor was Pat Corcoran. Mr. Dick has served as the Lower Columbia Area Safety Manager for the last 2 years.
