Mr. Hollis called regarding the planned visit of representatives of the Commission to the Uranium Reduction mill at Moab on Monday, July 16. He stated that he would welcome our visit; however, he wanted us to know that the mill was closed down the latter part of June and just started up again yesterday. Consequently, the mill, in all likelihood, will not be operating under typical conditions on Monday, July 16.

Mr. Hollis suggested that it might be advisable for us to consider postponing the visit for one week. I explained to Mr. Hollis that commitments were already made regarding visits during the weeks beginning July 15 and July 22, so that it would be difficult to change our planned itinerary. I told him that I would, nevertheless, check with other persons here who would be making the visit, to determine if they would prefer postponing the visit for a later date.

In conclusion, Mr. Hollis was informed that unless I called him to the contrary today or tomorrow we would plan to see him Monday, July 16.
